Policy Reference: Education Code Sections 5000 et seq. and 72036

The term of office of each trustee shall be four years, commencing on the first board meeting in December following the general election in November. Elections shall be held every two years, in even numbered years. Terms of the trustees are staggered so that, as nearly as practical, one half of the trustees shall be elected at each trustee election.

The Board of Trustees has established elections by trustee areas. In establishing trustee areas, the territory of the district has been divided into trustee areas, and one member of the Board of Trustees shall be elected from each trustee area. The Board of Trustees has provided for the election of trustees to represent the following trustee areas:

Effective October 6, 1992, the trustee areas are:

Area I: Dunsmuir, McCloud, Castella

Area II: Mt. Shasta

Area III: Big Springs, Butteville Union, Gazelle, Weed

Area IV: Yreka

Area V: Butte Valley Unified, Delphic, Grenada, Little Shasta, Montague
Tulelake, Willow Creek

Area VI: Scott Valley Unified, Forks of Salmon, Sawyers Bar

Area VII: Bogus, Fall Creek, Happy Camp Union, Hornbrook, Junction, Klamath River, Seiad

A candidate for election as a member of the Board of Trustees shall reside in, and be registered to vote in, the trustee area he or she seeks to represent.

The Superintendent/President shall submit recommendations to the Board of Trustees regarding adjustments to be made to the boundaries of each trustee area, if any adjustment is necessary, after each decennial federal census. The Superintendent/President shall submit the recommendation in time for the Board of Trustees to act as required by law.
