Once again, it is time for the College of the Siskiyous Performing & Visual Arts Camp. Celebrating its 20th Anniversary, we will offer campers two class choices, a vocal experience, performances by local performing artists as well as performance & gallery revue by participants.



It is our desire to offer students the opportunity to study the Performing & Visual Arts under the guidance of highly trained faculty. Those enrolled will receive an inspiring, enriching and tender introduction into the many areas of the arts.

This year, students may opt to bring their own lunches or buy one in the cafeteria for under \$6 each day. (subject to change) Camp will begin Monday, July 13 with an 8:30 am orientation meeting. Parents/guardians are urged to attend this brief introduction to the camp & it's activities. Please be on time so we can begin all classes on schedule. On all other days, students should be dropped off at the Theatre no later than 8:45 am & no earlier than 8:30 am.\* Each day begins with a short meeting before students are released to their first class.

The first week beginning Monday, July 13 will end on Friday, July 17.

The second week begins Monday, July 20 with an early evening performance & gallery exhibition ending the camp on Friday, June 24.

The program includes a choice of two classes, a lunch break followed by performances from local artists & instructors, and a vocal experience for all students. Classes meet daily Monday through Friday. The camp concludes with a Gallery Exhibition and Revue for family & friends on the final evening, Friday, July 24, 2009.

### Registration:

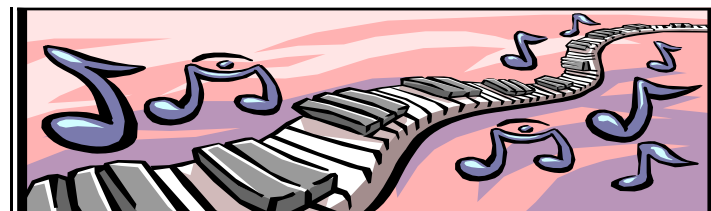
To register, complete all sides of the COS Application/Enrollment Form and the attached Performing & Visual Arts Camp registration form. Please select a first & second choice for the First & Second Hours. (A total of four different class choices.)

The camp fee of \$188 includes course registration and a T-shirt (Students should bring their own lunches or money to purchase lunches at the COS cafeteria.) The camp fee of \$259.50 includes course registration, a T-shirt, and lunches. (Fees includes a mandatory health fee). Mail or bring both forms, along with your check payable to College of the Siskiyous, to the address shown on the packet.

Class sizes are limited and will be filled by the date of registration. Be sure to register as early as possible to reserve your place and get your first choice of classes.

## *Class Descriptions*

### *Ballet:*

Students will explore the world of ballet and perform in the Camp Revue. (Grades 1-8)

### *Guitar:*

Don't miss the opportunity to learn about the guitar. Students will learn the basics. Bring your own instrument. (Grades 3-6 & Grades 7-8)

### *Dance: Creative Movement & Contemporary Dance*

Enjoy expressing yourself through movement to various styles of music. Learn how to create a dance in individual and group activities.  
(All Grades)

### *Graphic Arts:*

Drawing, paper sculpture, painting and various graphic art forms. Learn what talents you have! (Grades 1-4 and Grades 5-8)

### *Irish Step Dance:*

Learn the exciting art of Irish Step Dance and perform your dance in the Camp Revue. (Grades 4-8)

### *Art Goes Green:*

Using found, throwaway and recycled materials, students will design & create original new works of usable art. (Grade 1-4 and Grades 5-8)

## *Class Descriptions*

### *Mini & Maxi Drama:*

Have fun interacting with other students while learning the skills of acting. Class will prepare short drama presentations for the camp revue.  
(Mini: Grades 1-4 and Maxi: Grades 5-8)

### *Digital Photography:*

Explore principles of photography, digital photography basics & composition. Students will produce their photos for the Gallery Exhibition. (Grades 6-8)

### *Stage Management:*

Find out what goes on behind the scenes. Learn sound, lighting, set-up, and set design. Work with the Camp Revue production.  
(Grades 5-6 and Grades 7-8)

### *Video/Filmmaking Production:*

Students will learn principles of digital video techniques; camera, lighting & sound as well as editing basics. The class project is to create a newsmagazine style production showcasing the Camp experience. (Grades 5-6 and Grades 7-8)

### *We Can Sing!*

Students will explore different styles of vocal music & more. Share your talents in the camp revue. Experience not necessary!
