## **IF YOU ARE A NON-QUALIFIER**

- *Earn an Associate of Arts degree*
- *Earn 48-semester transferable units*
- *Have a cumulative GPA of 2.000*

### ■ **The Progress Toward Degree Rule – OR – 40/60/80 Rule**

-By the beginning of the student-athlete's **3<sup>rd</sup> year of college** enrollment, they must have completed **40%** of the classes required toward a specific degree.

-By the beginning of the student-athlete's **4<sup>th</sup> year of college** enrollment, they must have completed **60%** of the classes required toward a specific degree.

### ■ **If you transfer from the two-year school to the four-year school after August 1, 2009**

The transferrable credits **MUST** include:

6 semester unit of ENGLISH (ENGL 1A / ENGL 1C)

3 semester unit of MATH (MATH 2 / MATH 10 / MATH 4 / MATH 5A)

- **No more than 6-8 units may be from PE** (With the exception of PE Majors)

### ■ **Transferable Units at College of the Siskiyous are:**

**Any class with the course number 1 – 49**

Example of Transferable: **SPCH 1 / BIO 10 / ENGL 38**

Example of Non-Transferable: **MATH 54A / ENGL 52 / MATH 53**

### ■ **Five-year clock**

The first time you enroll anywhere as a full-time student, you start your five-year clock of eligibility. If you play in Division I, you have five-calendar years to play four seasons of competition. Your clock is running, even if you are not currently enrolled or even if you go part time within that time frame.
