The Art program at the College of the Siskiyous offers students a complete lower division transfer curriculum in Art as well as a wide selection of courses for the Associate in Arts major in Art. Foundation courses such as Art History, Painting, Ceramics, Drawing and Photography rely heavily on a historical component, which not only fulfills much of the general education transfer requirements in humanities, but will also allow students to critically examine, appreciate, and relate their own artwork to a historical perspective. Studio classes in Art provide students the opportunity to use the latest technology, facilities and equipment. A degree in Art can provide a variety of career opportunities and vocations in art such as photographer, fine artist, digital artist, art educator, and graphic designer. Students should consult with a counselor to determine whether this degree is the best option for their academic goals.

Important: To obtain the Associate in Arts Degree in Art, students must complete the following requirements with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0:

- The College of the Siskiyous General Education Pattern (COSGE) requirements.
- Any needed electives to reach a total of 60 COS degree-applicable units.
- All major courses and any courses noted on the COSGE check sheet must be completed with a C or better.
