

BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (AS-T)

The Business Administration program prepares the student for a variety of careers in a business environment. This option is intended for students who plan to complete a bachelor's degree in a similar major at a California State University (CSU) campus. Students should consult with a counselor to determine whether this degree is the best option for their transfer goals.

Important: To obtain the Associate in Science Degree in Business Administration for Transfer, students must complete the following requirements with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0:

- The Business Administration major requirements below.
- The California State University General Education – Breadth (CSUGE) **or** the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) requirements.
- Any needed transferable electives to reach a total of 60 CSU transferable units.
- All major courses and any courses noted on the CSUGE or IGETC check sheets must be completed with a C or better.

 - MATH 1010- Finite Mathematics (3)
 - MATH 1050- Elementary Statistics (4)
- List B: Complete **two** of the following: -----6-7 units*
 - Any course from List A not already used (3-4)
 - BA 1006- Introduction to Business (3)
 - CSCI 1001- Introduction to Computer Science (3)

Total Units ----- 26-28

Double counting courses in GE and the major is permissible (6-8 units from the major requirements can be counted in GE)
