

MUSIC (AA-T)

The Music program at College of the Siskiyous offers coursework in the areas of vocal performance, instrumental performance, and music and theater performance. The coursework includes theory, keyboarding, and ear training skills. This program prepares students for one of the many careers in music; broadens their general knowledge of music; and develops performance skills and the option to pursue an advanced degree in music. The Associate of Arts in Music for Transfer will prepare students for further studies toward a California State University (CSU) baccalaureate degree in Music. Students should consult with a counselor to determine whether this degree is the best option for their transfer goals.

Important: To obtain the Associate in Arts Degree in Music for Transfer, students must complete the following requirements with a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0:

- The Music major requirements below.
- The California State University General Education – Breadth (CSUGE) **or** the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) requirements. ****Please note: Area 6-Languages Other Than English on the IGETC is *NOT* required for the AA-T.**
- Any needed transferable electives to reach a total of 60 CSU transferable units.
- All major courses and any courses noted on the CSUGE or IGETC check sheets must be completed with a C or better.
