An Associate in Arts in Psychology provides relevant educational experiences for students seeking employment in a variety of fields, including helping professions, teaching, medicine, public service and business. It also intends to enhance students' self- awareness, personal adjustment, awareness of others, and critical thinking ability. Students should consult with a counselor to determine whether this degree is the best option for their academic goals.
