

FIREFIGHTER I

Certificate: Firefighter I- FIRE 0950 (631-Hour Program)

This is the basic Firefighter I Academy course. Students successfully completing the class will be eligible for California State Fire Marshal Certification as a Firefighter I and will be qualified for entry level firefighter positions in State, County, and, municipal fire departments.

Students must contact Debbie Dutcher to receive a permit to register. A permit will be issued when a student can show proof of an EMT Basic or First Responder Medical certification or proof (registration in EMS 1001 or comparable course at another institution) they are attempting to complete the co requisite prior to the end of the Firefighter I Academy. EMS 1001 or EMS 0965 must be completed with a B grade or better. Students will also be required to pass a physical agility test. **A limited number of permits will be issued.** A priority wait list will be created for any excess.
