**INSTRUCTION SHEET**

Dear Dunsmuir Scholarship Fund ALUMNI Applicant:

The Board of Directors of the Dunsmuir Scholarship Fund (DSF) plans to award a sizeable amount in scholarships this year. If your application is to be considered by the Committee, you must attach the following **in order**:

- 1) A properly completed and appropriately signed **application** (Include page 2 and 3 of this packet); **AND**, the following items: **(Please note: Extra information and enclosures additional to that requested below will NOT be reviewed.)**;
- 2) A short **TYPED essay** (NOT more than 1 page and NOT to exceed 500 words) describing your plans for future education; i.e. school of your choice, major, occupational goals, and any other pertinent information;
- 3) A reference **letter** from one college faculty member or counselor **commenting upon your educational progress**. (If not currently enrolled in school, this should be a letter from your current employer.)
- 4) A copy of an **unofficial transcript(s)** for all college work from the school most recently attended, reflecting an accumulated GPA of not less than 2.50. Please pick up transcripts personally and send them with your application.

**DEADLINE**: Applications must be postmarked, or received by DSF **no later than April 15th**. For your protection, you should purchase a "Certificate Of Mailing" when you send your application by mail. If the Committee asks you to verify the date that you mailed the application, you must have the "Certificate Of Mailing" to present to them. Return your completed application to:
