



The Christina Madrigal Memorial Scholarship Fund Scoring System & Procedure

The Christina Madrigal Memorial Scholarship Fund application scoring system uses a point system for each of the following criteria: application (20 possible points), volunteer service (20 possible points), references (10 possible points), and overall written essay (50 possible points), which should include where and when their child attends/attended Shasta Head Start, benefits their family have received from the program, future educational goals, volunteer service performed at Shasta Head Start, future family goals, personal life goals and career goals.

Before the review meeting, assigned reviewers will determine preliminary scores for each of the scored review criteria and a preliminary overall score for each applicant. The Scholarship Committee will then meet as a group to review all the students' applications. The scores will assist the Committee in the selection process of the scholarship winner.

All decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.
