Criteria for Awarding: This scholarship is offered to a Siskiyou County high school graduate who is enrolled in the COS Fire Fighter 1 Academy to be held during the 2018 spring semester.

- The student must carry a 2.5 grade point average while attending COS
- Submit a one page letter detailing why they are enrolling in the COS Fire Fighter I Academy at College of the Siskiyou.
- The recipient of this award will also be required to serve 30 hours of community service during the spring semester with the Fire Science Program (Fire Fighter Academy).

The recipient of this scholarship will be notified of award in May 2018 during the Fire Fighter Academy graduation and satisfactory completion of the Fire Fighter I Academy and community service hours.

Mac DeCausmaker was a Scott Valley native. He graduated from Etna High School in 1999 and attended College of the Siskiyou as a student in the Fire Science Program, graduating with an Associate Degree. He was also an emergency medical technician and a volunteer with the Fort Jones Fire Department. In 2002 Mac began his career with CalFIRE following completion of the Fire Fighter I Academy at COS. Mac later attended and graduated from the CalFIRE Company Officer Academy in Lone, CA. As a Fire Fighter I and a Fire Apparatus Engineer, Mac worked throughout Siskiyou County, and was currently assigned to the CalFIRE Pondsosa Fire Station as a fire apparatus engineer. The family and friends of Mac DeCausmaker established this scholarship.
