WHEREAS, the College of the Siskiyou Auxiliary Foundation generates community support, financial resources, community partnerships, related to strengthening the College's image and success,


WHEREAS, these efforts enable the District to experience an enhanced resource base, more discretionary money, improved public image, build networking partnerships and greater service to and from the community,

WHEREAS, the staff of the Foundation Office provide leadership to volunteer staff, community networks, community partnerships, and management coordination to special events,


