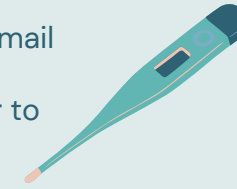
Wear a face covering

Report to a check-in station

Submit documentation of negative COVID-19 test

(taken after August 1, 2020) if you have returned from travel or are relocating from outside Siskiyou County. Self-isolate for 14 days only if prescribed by Siskiyou County Public Health Department prior to being on campus. Area of Commute* is excluded from mandatory testing while conducting normal activities.

Please note: in the case of a previous positive test, clearance to be on campus must be obtained from a medical professional. For example, if you had a positive test result from previously having had COVID-19, but you're recovered, you then need to turn in a doctor's note to verify you are well enough to attend college.

All test result documents must be submitted to Janice Gonzalez by e-mailing studentservices@siskiyous.edu, or call for an appointment to drop off paperwork at (530) 938-5374.

*Area of Commute: This term broadens the defined boundaries of Siskiyou County to include commuting areas where many people either live and commute, or travel to for a day-trip to shop, receive services, etc. Examples include Redding, Ashland, Medford, Klamath Falls, etc....
