- 4) Working with student, faculty administration, staff and the Associated Student Board

- 7) Carry out regular duties: ASB meetings, Newsletter, Log book, ASB functions, etc.

PETITIONS MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE STUDENT LIFE OFFICE BY THURSDAY DAY, April 18, 2019 AT 12PM (noon), for spring elections.

At the time of turning in your petition your picture will be taken for your ASB card and to be used for the election. You may start campaigning as soon as your petition is approved.

Elections will be held on April 24, 2019 from 9am-2pm in the Student Center.

Petition Instructions

- READ the attached material and requirements carefully.
- Answer the questions to your best ability. The petitions will be posted to be read by the voters, so write our type legibly
- Return petitions to the Student Life office for processing.
- DUE DATE FOR RETURNING PETITIONS 4/18/19 , NOON
- Have your picture taken for an ASB card and to be posted by your petition for candidate recognition.

Requirements

- You must maintain a grade point average of at least 2.0 throughout your one-year term of office.
- You must be enrolled in at least 6.0 units throughout your term of office.
- You must be willing to spend two hours weekly staffing the ASB office, working with and helping others students.
- You must be willing to attend and support the activities sponsored by the ASB (dances, special events, etc.)
- You must be willing to represent the student and serve on campus committees, working with faculty, administration and staff
- You must conduct yourself in such a way that would not reflect poorly on ASB during your term of office.
- You must have an ASB card for each semester you are in office.
