Space Available in Communications Classes

Weed / COS –Students majoring in communications or who are interested in improving their public speaking or interpersonal communication skills are encouraged to register for fall semester classes at College of the Siskiyous.

Public Speaking (COMS 1100 / #7034) will be offered as a two-way video conferencing class that will meet at the Yreka and Weed Campuses. This class will teach the basic principles and practices of public speaking: developing proficiency and self-confidence in speaking. Focus will also include organization, development and communication of ideas, structure, style, and delivery. Doran Donnell will teach this three unit class that will meet Monday and Wednesday mornings from 7:25 to 8:50 a.m. Class will begin Wednesday, August 30.

Interpersonal Communications (COMS 1500 / #7042) will meet at the Weed Campus in the Science Building room 7-219. This course is an introduction to the process of human communication with a focus on intra and inter personal communication. Special emphasis is placed on an understanding of communication in relationships and everyday life including how to communicate ideas, thoughts, and feelings. Also, study of theory and research findings and their application to communication in personal and professional contexts as well as principles of verbal and nonverbal transactions. Michelle Gaddini will teach this three unit class that will meet on Thursday evenings from 6:50 to 10 p.m. Class will begin August 31.

Students who are interested in registering for either of these classes should do so as soon as possible before the start date.
