### **Register Now for COS Administration of Justice Program Class Beginning January 30**

Weed / COS - Registration is currently open for **Introduction to Administration of Justice (ADJ 1001 / #3099 and #3100)**. This class will meet on Tuesday and Thursday from 12:10 to 1:35 p.m. utilizing two-way videoconferencing. The class will meet at the Yreka Campus Rural Health Sciences Institute and the Weed Campus Distance Learning Center. "What does justice mean to you? How does our criminal justice system ensure justice for all?" This course introduces students to the criminal justice system in the United States and the roles of the police, courts and corrections in shaping justice policy. Focus is placed on crime measurement, explanations of crime, responses to crime, and current challenges. The course also examines the evolution of the justice system and the forces that shape justice policy in a cross-cultural context.
