 - iv. While there is great support from the Board and the Administration, we have to admit a problem before we can fix it.
 - v. There are people who think they are aligned, but they say something that shows that they aren't aligned.
 - vi. Lack of professionalism in Town Hall Survey, such as personal attacks.
 - vii. It seems that we are dealing with correcting the symptoms instead of the fundamental issues.
 - viii. There are many unsafe spaces and unsafe people on this campus. The Town Hall also made that clear with comments about disinterest in racial equity trainings.

 - i. Selena Johnson (student rep) recommended to collaborate with ASB to address safety concerns by having Title IX trainings, Student Advocates, adding lighting, etc.... The ASB is already going to take a tour with Maintenance regarding lighting in dimly lit areas.
