State Fire Training Minimum Requirements to teach at the Fire Academy

The information below is from the State Fire Training Bulletin on July 22, 2019.

Fire Fighter I / II Academy Instructor Requirements

Starting January 1, 2019, new instructors for Fire Fighter I and Fire Fighter II academies will be required to meet the following requirements:

- Instructor I Certification (40 Hours Instructional Experience and completed Task Book)
- Ethical Leadership in the Classroom
- Fire Fighter 1 Certification
- Fire Fighter 2 Certification to teach those skills

Current Academy Instructors (those who were instructing at the ALA/ARTP on/before December 31, 2018) maintain their status even though they may not be "Certified Instructors." To qualify for this exemption, you must have a "Fire Fighter 1 & 2 Instructor" listed in your Acadis certifications. SFT runs a quarterly report looking for the above certifications and then adds this certification automatically to your Acadis.
