*Completion of High School 10th Grade English or higher.

*Successfully complete a background clearance.

If you have any past convictions, there is a possibility you may be disqualified from the CNA program and from obtaining state licensure.

- *Successfully complete a drug screening.
- *You must be at least 16 years of age.
- *Meet or exceed the minimum health and physical requirements.
- *Successfully pass a physical examination. Provide a copy of current immunization records and/or complete the required immunizations for communicable diseases, including Hepatitis B, TDAP and TB test
- *Current American Heart Association Health Care Provider CPR Card.
- *Access to **RELIABLE** transportation to and from the clinical site.
- * Covid-19 Testing may be required.
