

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
COLLEGE OF THE SISKIYOU FOUNDATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is COLLEGE OF THE SISKIYOU FOUNDATION.

ARTICLE II

A. This corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.

B. The specific and primary purposes of this corporation are to engage in the solicitation, receipt, and administration of property and, from time to time, to disburse such property and the income therefrom, to, or for the benefit of, College of the Siskiyou for cultural, educational, and community service purposes.

ARTICLE III

ARTICLE IV

The county in the State of California where the principal office for the transaction of the business of this corporation is to be located is the County of Siskiyou.

ARTICLE V


This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.


The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director or officer thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation

or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
