CPR for the Professional Rescuer

Weed / COS – College of the Siskiyous will offer **CPR for the Professional Rescuer (EMS 0950 / #1030)** one-day only on Saturday, January 30 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. This class will meet at the Weed Campus in the Emergency Services Training Center (ESTC) room 8-113.

This course meets the American Heart Association Provider and American Red Cross Professional Rescuer CPR Guidelines. This course will teach professional rescuers the skills needed to care for cardiac arrest, respiratory arrest, or airway obstruction in the infant, child, and adult. Training in CPR, AED, and airway management will be observed. Upon successful completion, the student will receive a CPR card from the National Safety Council that is good for two years.

Be sure to register early to get the classes you need and want.
